**Terms and Conditions:**

- ◆ Committee members will be elected at and required to attend the Victoria/ Tasmania Branch General Meetings
- ◆ An elected committee member holds office until the termination of the next General Meeting held after his or her election. This is between 12- 14 months, pending date of General Meeting.
- ◆ Elected committee members are required to attend monthly meetings and subcommittee meetings and contribute to some hours outside of work time.
- ◆ If more than 13 nominations are received, a ballot will be held before the General Meeting to assist rural members to be involved in the process of choosing the general committee. All financial members are eligible to vote, and corporate memberships permitted one vote only.
- ◆ Formal election of leadership positions (President, Vice President, Secretary and Chairs) will take place at the General Meeting. If more than one nomination is received for each of these positions a ballot will be held among elected committee members.
- ◆ Each candidate for election must:
  - (1) be proposed by an ordinary member or the nominated representative of a corporate member; and
  - (2) be seconded by another ordinary member or the nominated representative of another corporate member; both members must be current financial members of the AHPA at the time of nomination.
- ◆ No ordinary member or nominated representative of a corporate member may propose more than one person as a candidate but may second more than one nomination.
- ◆ Nomination of a candidate for election must:
  - (1) be in writing;
  - (2) be signed by the candidate; and
  - (3) be signed by the proposer and seconder.
