

2019 Health Promotion Scholarship Program

Want to kick start your career in health promotion?

Applications are now open for the AHPA (WA Branch) 2019 Health Promotion Scholarship Program funded by Healthway.

FOUR scholarships are on offer for 2019:

- One graduate scholarship;
- One Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander scholarship;
- One regional scholarship; and
- One of any category.

Each scholarship offered is for a six-month full-time paid health promotion work placement under the supervision of an appropriately experienced health promotion professional (part-time options can be negotiated). The successful applicant's salary (plus 20% on-costs) is funded by the scholarship with access to additional professional development funding.

Applicants must meet ONE of the following requirements:

- **Undergraduate or postgraduate student** in the final year of a health promotion, health science, preventative health or public health degree at a Western Australian university;
- **Completed a tertiary qualification** in health promotion, health science, preventative health or public health at a Western Australian university **within the past 12 months**; OR
- **Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person** who has work or volunteer experience and/or TAFE/University qualifications in Aboriginal health, nursing, youth work, teaching or related fields.
